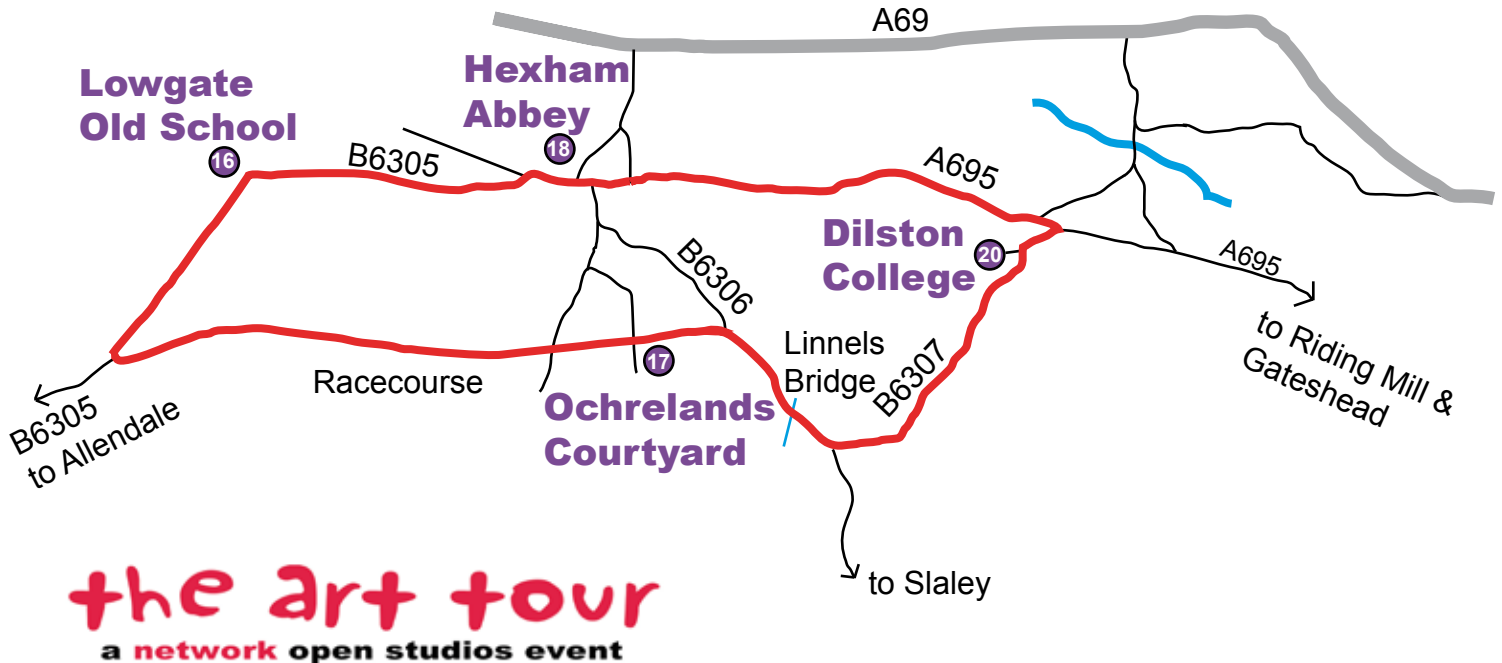


Castles Countryside and Churches

Visitor information

Studio 20: Dilston College (not 14 or 21 June)

A new venue this year with work from final year college students. View John Griffin's striking black and white designs and Joseph Rolls' paintings inspired by landscape and people.

Also at this venue

'Historic Dilston' ruined castle and archeological dig – open Sundays 11 – 4pm

Studio 17: Unit 3 Ochrelands Workshops

The Byre Studio - a new venue for Catherine Stott's work. New paintings and monoprints inspired by northern and Scottish gardens plus local festivals and highland landscapes.

Also at this venue

Plant Sale at Ochrelands House (not 21 June) On behalf of the Great North Air Ambulance - follow the signs from the studio.

Studio 16: Lowgate Old School

Windows, reflections, framed views and the changing light of the landscape are major themes of work in June Drage's new studio.

Also at this venue

Come and see how the former school building has been converted.

Studio 18: Hexham Abbey

A varied group of artists are on show here. View Wyn Barnes' landscape and still life photography, Claire Myers' vibrant animal paintings, Jill Dexter's woven textiles, Janet Rogers' stained glass and Sara Jane Palmer's ceramic sculptures and hangings.

Also at this venue

Watch a weaving demonstration; tour the Abbey Church, historic seat of St Wilfred.

From 28 June, visit studio 19 in Market Street Hexham, a new venue with work by painters Penny Grennan and Linda Kent.
